- 6. Third, we will elevate efforts to further enhance the progress in Goal 12 by making collective actions towards sustainability such as strengthening legal and institutional frameworks including financial support to ensure sustainable

management and efficient use of resources and creating economic opportunities from green and circular economy models.

7. Fourth, we are committed to implementing energy transition pathways towards clean and low-carbon energy by promoting actionable and pragmatic energy transition solutions for achieving the SDGs and climate goals while ensuring energy security.

- 8. These transformative actions require **all of us to work together**.

 This means that **global support and resources need to be strengthened**.
- We must also continue to embrace the important role and contribution of all members of society including nongovernment organisations.
- 10. Overall, Brunei Darussalam is confident that at this Summit, we can create this ecosystem better and we stand ready to build it together.
